

Restrictions lifted in Continuing Care effective July 13, 2021

Phase 1



Visitors will no longer be limited in number or conditions. Screening and Mask wearing in common areas is still required. Masks may be removed in private rooms or spaces if preferred.



Visitors who are not fully vaccinated, including children under age 12, should continue to wear masks at all times in all areas of the building.



Residents are no longer required to be screened or quarantined except when returning from an outbreak unit of a health-care facility.



All limits to dining and recreation activities for residents are removed.



Operators have until July 31, 2021 to fully implement.

Restrictions Still In Place:



- Screening upon entry and continuous masking for staff, students, volunteers and service providers
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfection routines in common areas
- Single-site staffing requirements
- Testing guidelines
- Isolation and quarantine protocols
- Outbreak procedures

Phase 2
