Programs

Supportive Living

- 187 residences and 261 seniors' households served annually in Black Diamond, High River and Okotoks.
- 570 meals served daily.
- 97 employees, 24 hour staffing.

Affordable Housing

- 130 residences and 265 households served annually in Black Diamond, Blackie, Bragg Creek, Cayley, Claesholm, High River, Lomond, Nanton, Okotoks, Turner Valley and Vulcan.
- Rent Supplement provides \$775,000 in annual rental payments to households.
- 4 employees.

Near Market Housing

- 84 residences and 96 households served annually in Black Diamond, High River, Okotoks and Turner Valley.
- 2 employees.
